Hello Blue Room families! We would like to start off by thanking all the families who participated in our Multi Cultural Night! We hope everyone had a great time.

We are very excited to kick off the month of December by learning about holidays around the world! During literacy, students will sequence the story The Gingerbread Man by using cut out pictures to recreate the story and then use their own words retell what happened in the book. For math/science, students will learn about Hanukah and make edible menorahs out of pretzels, chocolate chips, and marshmallows. For art, students will make a 3-D paper plate Christmas tree by painting their paper plate green, as well as glue on pom poms and glitter as their ornaments.

During the second week of December, students will focus on the theme winter. For literacy, students will write letters to Santa explaining what they would like for the Christmas. During math, students will identify and write numbers in the pretend snow writing trays. At art, students will design sparkly snowflakes by gluing on rhinestones to their popsicle stick snowflakes.
