We will start off the month by talking about the circus! For literacy, the children will collectively brainstorm the wonderful things they might see at the circus. For math and science, the children will practice counting using gumballs and create a circus tent using toothpicks and marshmallows. The children will use their fine motor skills for art to create their own cotton candy masterpiece.

For our second week, we will explore the wild west theme. For literacy, the children will put on their mining hat and dig for gold letters. For math and science, the children will create horseshoe patterns at the light table and create dancing corn as part of a science experiment with Ms. Amber. For art, the children will have the opportunity to create their own cactus using their amazing art skills.

On our third week, we will talk about robots and inventions. The children will practice their literacy skills to create their name using a metal tray and magnetic letters. For math they will use linking cubes to measure a robot and they will put on their scientist hats to test what items stick to our jumbo magnet. For art, the children will create a geometric robot.

On week four and five, we will talk about a classroom favoritedinosaurs! They will practice their writing skills to trace dinosaur letters. For science, Ms. Amber will facilitate a volcano experiment and for math, the children will use geometric tiles to create a dinosaur. The class will wrap up the week by painting a dinosaur.
