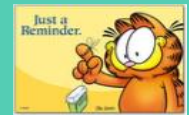
March is here already! The year has really flown by! We have several exciting things planned for the kids this month!

To start off March, the theme this week is St. Patrick's Day, and the letter of this week is letter X. We will be celebrating St. Patrick's Day by making some fun artwork, such as painting shamrocks, rainbows, leprechauns, and make a wreath. For math, we will begin learning how to subtract, count with shamrocks and count by 10's. For literacy, we will work on CVC words, and write a journal entry about what they would do if they were a leprechaun.

In the second week of March, we will be learning all different types of weather. For science, we will make several weather sensory bottles, and we will make a solution to make snow how exciting! For literacy, we will work on rhyming words, and beginning sounds. For math, we will work on creating a weather graph, and counting with ten frames.

For the third week of March, it is the beginning of Spring season yay! We will have Spring and Easter activities. For arts and crafts, we will be painting an easter egg, make an easter bunny, and decorate a spring greeting card. For literacy, we will be learning ending sound words, work on compound words, and opposites. For math, children will practice to write numbers from 1-50.

For the last week of March, the theme is wetland and pond animals. For literacy, we will work on sight words, and write pond animal vocabulary words on a dry erase board. For science, we be learning all about the life cycle of a frog, children will practice to draw the shapes and write the number of sides in each shape. For art, we will make a pond life craft, paint ducks, and dab paint the cattails with cotton balls.



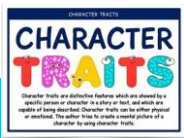
