Spring is the time of the year when we see our nature so bright with flowers blooming!

The first week of May, we will be busy working on our Mother's Day gathering. The kids are very excited for this special day! For art, we will be focusing on Mother's Day gifts. For literacy, we will be learning rhyming words, and write family words. For math, we will work on addition,

and compare numbers from greatest to least.

The second week of May, we will be learning all about gardening. For science, we are learning to write parts of a plant, seed sequencing, and planting grass. For art, we will paint tulip flowers using a plastic fork, and create a poster about the life cycle of a plant.

The third week of May, we will learn about grocery markets, and Farmer's markets. For literacy, we are learning to write the grocery list, sight words, and beginning sounds. For math and science, we will count, sort fruits, and vegetables, and learn about healthy food. For art, children will be painting strawberries, cut eggplant shapes, and apple stamps.

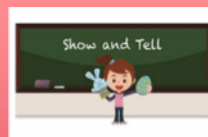


Outdoor time begins promptly at 9:00 A.M. We ask that you get to school before so your child can enjoy some free play time outside.
