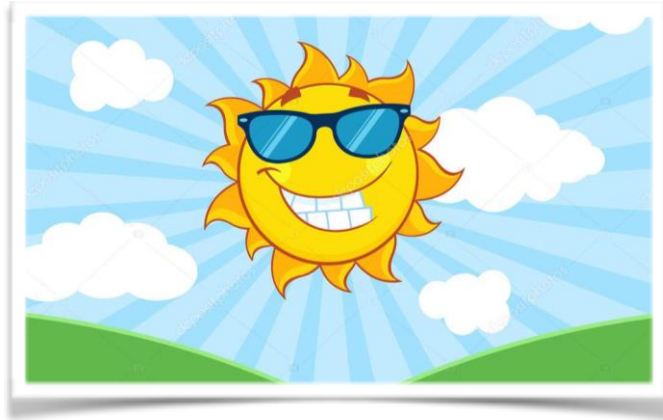


# Orange Newsletter

As the sun shines over August, we say goodbye and best of luck to our Orange Room friends who will soon be starting at a new school! We also want to welcome new friends who are transitioning to the Orange Room. We are excited to have you!

To start off August, we will be having a Circus/Carnival theme, it will be filled with fun crafts. Crafts will consist of making a circus tent, clown, popcorn, and cotton candy. For literacy, we will begin learning blend words, and letter M. For math, we will be working on addition and learning about quantities.

In the second week of August, the theme is Wild West and the letter of this week is N. The craft for this week is painting and decorating a cactus, cowboy boot, cowboy hat, and cowboy/cowgirl. For literacy, we will be learning about punctuation marks, and beginning sounds. For science, we will explore cause and effect on a cactus sponge experiment.

The third week of August, we will dedicate to the famous American inventors, like Thomas Edison who invented the incandescent lightbulb, Alexander Graham Bell who invented the telephone, and the Wright brothers who invented the first flyer. Letter of this week is O, and for literacy we will be learn phonics, and work on emergent reader. For arts, we will do crafts that will represent the American inventors, we will paint a lightbulb, and we will use empty toilet paper rolls to make a telephone from the 1876. For math children will practice writing and memorize one parent phone number.

In the fourth week of August, the theme is all about Dinosaurs, this will be an exciting theme to learn about! For science, we will experiment with frozen dinosaurs on ice cubes. Children will experiment with thawing the dinosaurs to free them, and experiment what paleontologists do to search for dinosaurs' fossils. For literacy, the letter this week is letter P, and we will practice writing on the dinosaurs word wall on dry erase boards, while for arts and crafts we will paint dinosaurs, dinosaur egg, and make dinosaur fossils from dough.

For the last week of August, the theme is royalty, and the letter of this week is Q. For arts and crafts, we will make a friendship quilt with our handprints, and paint and build a castle with empty paper towel rolls. For literacy, we will work on letter R blends, and for science we will experiment with baking soda to make fizzy frozen stars.

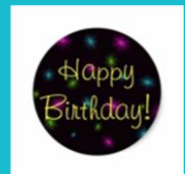
